It was founded in 2009 with named "Department Recreation" in Fırat University Sports Science Faculty.

There are 11 classrooms, 1 massage room, 1 test and conditioning room, 1 table tennis room, 1 grass field, 1 track and field area, 1 multipurpose sports hall and tennis courts in our School of Physical Education and Sports.

Admission Requirements

Students are taken with the Special Talent Examination. It needs to be graduated from a high school or an equivalent school for Special Talent Examination and get the current rating for the grid specified in Transition Exam to Higher Education (TEHE).
